- 4. President's Report: Michelle
 - a. Halloween parade is next week (Saturday at 11am)
 - b. Trick or Treating is on October 31st

 - d. Treasurer has been found. Tom Brennan will join the board in January 2024.
- 5. Treasurer's Report: Michelle
 - a. Approval of September 2023 report
 - b. Monthly update
 - i. Beginning balance: \$76,483.35
 - ii. Ending balance: \$74,329.85
 - iii. Expenses this month include landscaping, utilities.
 - iv. Collected 320/338 of homeowner dues (95%) for FY24.

- 5. "Is there anything the Mariner's Cove Community Association (MCCA) can do to improve the quality of living in this community?"
 - a. Yes (4), no (5).
 - b. Definitely need to enforce bylaws! Way too much being allowed that is causing a decline in value of neighborhood.
 - c. DNA Dog poop testing to fine the people leaving dog crap & not picking it up.
 - d. It would be great if we had an email list serv for residents or specific online message board that was not part of Facebook.
 - e. The Druce lake beach is a huge asset to our neighborhood. With all the young families that have been using it this past summer the swim area gets a little crowded. It would be great if we could upgrade our swim area and ropes. It would be so nice if we could expand the swim area to the edge of the rocks and push it back ten

feet ish for the big kids. **ACTION:** Carola will take on this suggestion.

- 7. Several people responded that they would be interested in getting involved. Will communicate the contact details separately.
- ii. Michelle: paper option
 - 1. 8 surveys
 - 2. Have lived here a variety of years 4-37 years
 - 3. Lakes, water, friendly neighbors, quiet neighborhood, nature
 - 4. Druce Beach Improvements, Boat Lauch improvements, new community events were top areas that people would like to see improved
 - a. Additional topics that were noted: Canoe/kayak launch area, more get togethers.
 - 5. "Is there anything the Mariner's Cove Community Association (MCCA) can do to improve the quality of living in this community?"
 - a. Possibility of helping people recognize yard/plant maintenance issues at their home.
- 7. Ponds update: Steve
 - Final inspection two weeks ago. Overall very positive but inspector asked to pay attention to sump pump areas for erosion. Finalizing report and reimbursement request.
 - b. Encap will reseed areas along the large pond in late fall.
 - c. Drone pictures: Margie
 - i. Pictures of before and after will be used in final report and supplied to homeowners and Village.
 - d. Diffused air system: Margie/Steve
 - i. Similar to bubbler on Third Lake.
 - ii. Suggested three for large pond and two for small pond; compressor is used to push air. Soundproof box can be procured.
 - iii. Maintenance would be required. **ACTION**: would need an estimate on yearly cost.
 - iv. Would like the board to visit a site where we can see the equipment.
- 8. Village update: Mayor Butch Buckley
 - Delays in federal budget for MVT led to road resurfacing being pushed to 2024.
 - b. Will hold an open house in Spring to show new Public Works building and Third Lake Dam Park (grass area in front on Village Hall).
 - c. Village has older buoys that may be repurposed for swim area (will need new decals).
 - d. New ordinances will be published in the next few months.

- e. Trick or Treating is on Halloween (4-7pm).
- f. Dam is open Nov 1. All piers, toys, lifts should be removed by Nov 1.
- g. Option to "buy" bricks to place near flagpole.
- 9. Landscaping Committee Report: Margie
 - a. Seeding Druce Lake Peninsula
 - b. Juarez has some additional work remaining on Druce Lake Beach area.
 - c. Sink hole in pond has been filled.
 - d. Another sink hole on peninsula has been identified. Will be filled in.
 - e. **ACTION**: decide on sponsorship bench plaques (good for lifetime? Yearly?)
- 10. Lockbox on launches: Margie
 - a. Knox padlocks for Fire Department access
 - b. Motion to approve two Knox padlocks: Margie
 - i. Second: Michelle. All approve.
